

SINGLET USE & CARE

BSYWC singlets shall be distributed to each wrestler upon receipt of a valid check or cash for security deposit, in the amount determined by the Board; deposits shall be returned to the wrestler's family, contingent upon the singlet being returned in reasonable condition, at the discretion of the Board; deposit checks or cash will be retained by BSYWC if the singlet is returned damaged beyond normal wear or appearance, or if the singlet is lost or stolen.

BSYWC-issued singlets must be worn at all BSYWC-affiliated or –sponsored wrestling events; personal singlets may only be worn at events not sponsored by or affiliated with BSYWC. BSYWC singlets must only be worn to competitions and may not be worn for practice or personal use.

Allow yourself adequate time to wash and dry singlets. In order to maximize the life of the garments, you must follow these Care Instructions:

- ONLY machine wash with like colors and synthetic fabrics, in COLD water. Do not wash in hot water or with rougher materials, such as towels or denim.
- ONLY use mild, non-phosphorus detergents; phosphates can cause bleeding in the fabric.
- NEVER wash with bleach.
- DO NOT use fabric softener; fabric softener compromises material's wicking capabilities.
- Remove from washing machine promptly after final rinse cycle.
- ONLY hang-dry indoors (recommended) or tumble dry low, no heat.
- DO NOT iron.

Return singlet in zip lock bag and include these original instructions. Be sure to include the wrestler's name and list any known damages on the reverse side.
